Derren Ohanian will show us the importance of social network marketing and give tips on how to use it in today's ever-growing technology age especially as related to artists of all genres.


Naseem Hyder has worked in all areas of web development, programming and design since her graduation from the UCSB Computer Science program in 2000. She has designed personal web pages and blogs.
